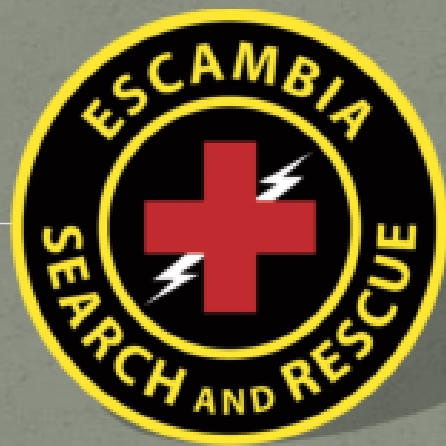


ESCAMBIA SEARCH & RESCUE

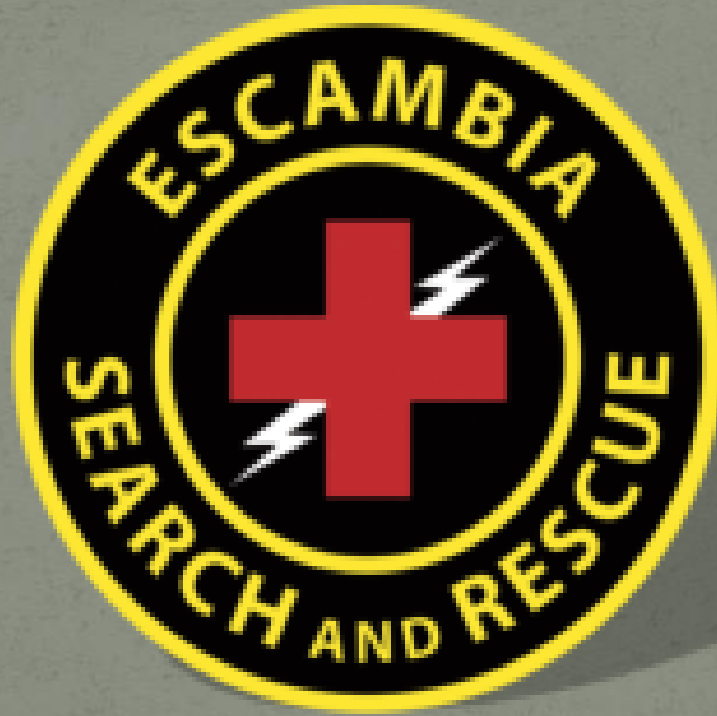

- Life jacket/kill switch/fire extinguish/horn-whistle/radio/EPIRB
- Kayaks & paddleboarders, Make sure they see you!!
- Stay alert, avoid distractions, hydrate but avoid alcohol
